Mr. Daniel Miller and his 3 sons, would like to tap the maple trees in the well field, told no due to EPA standards and well head protection program.

Finance: Cindy stated the credit card payments on line for Income Tax will be up and running, discussion of charging a fee of up to 3%: TPP tax down and also gone by 2014; compare last March to this March for totals.

SCMR & LANDS & BUILDINGS: discussion on storm drains, Mr. Cook wants the storm drain in his driveway fixed, it needs a raiser; also he would like a storm drain put in front of the Valley Feed Mill; Mr. Hartz informed council that if we do the catch basins south of town anywhere between \$600.00 to \$1,000.00; concern was going on personal property and the Village being responsible; Mark, Larry and David will talk to Mr. Nevison and explain the process; Mark needs truck bed sand blasted and painted, get quote; money for Leffingwell paving project will be release July 1st; GV East proposal the Mayor and Mr. Smolen have been working on it, asphalt can't predict a price; Mark can get 3 more loads of asphalt grindings; Mayor Bottoms went over Staley Road project, the Township is going to do some paving and we can have the county do this when they do the Townships part, will get a better price later in the year; discussion on the True North contract, David McCombs will look at it and put on May's agenda.

SAFETY: fire hall floor paint is coming off; replacing bulb in projector, Mr. Hartz will see if a flat screen TV will be cheaper than getting a new projector.

CLERK'S: Cindy stated she was offered a part time job as Rock Creek Finance Officer and would like Councils approval, as long as doesn't interfere with the Village of Orwell business.
